night, or early morning to spend time before Our
Lord, thanking Him for the supreme gift of Holy
Communion, and for all that it means in your life.

At the end of the 11.0am Mass, the Procession of
the Blessed Sacrament will take place, with
Benediction at an outdoor Altar in the course of it.

CORPUS CHRISTI ADORATION

What this is all about – the worship which we
offer at the Corpus Christi Masses, and the
adoration given when the Blessed Sacrament is
enthroned upon the Altar in the monstrance – is
about responding to the amazing love of Our Lord
Jesus Christ, who deigns to come amongst and
give himself to us in the Holy Sacrament. His love
amazes us, and so does his profound humility –
that he should allow bread and wine to be
transformed into his very self., so that he may give
himself to us, as our sustenance for this life, and as
the food of our immortality.

This Corpus Christi weekend, we are seeking
to respond to love with love. To give Our Lord the
time, the attention, the love, which he deserves. It
is about giving, rather than getting – as is our
attendance at Mass. We don't come to Mass to
'get' something, but to give something. We don't
come to enjoy ourselves, to meet up with our
friends, to pass the time, or to 'get' warm
religious feelings. We come rather to give, to give
to God the love and worship which are rightly his.
Hopefully, though, we will get much in return for
keeping this holy time in the Church's year : a
deeper love for our Lord, & a deeper trust in him
