## THE YEAR OF FAITH

The Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, has proclaimed a Year of Faith, which he will inaugurate on October 11th. The objectives are the deepening of the faith of ourselves as Catholics, and the sharing of the Faith with other people. (Already in this piece, I've used the F-word with a capital F and a lower-case F. When we use the capital, we are referring to THE Faith – the content of what we believe and seek to practice. When we use a lower case F, we mean our own acceptance of the reality of God, our trust in his love, his goodness, his truth.)

Our Parish Pastoral Council has begun to think about how we might mark and practice the Year of Faith in our Parish. One of the items which we have decided upon is another CAFÉ Course, a new one which has been made available on the Saints, those men and women of faith. The Course will take place over six weeks, and the Saints we will study are St. Patrick '*SPREADING THE GOOD NEWS*', St. Benedict '*A RHYTHM OF PRAYER*', St. Francis of Assisi '*GOD'S HEART FOR THE POOR*', St. Catherine of Siena '*HOLINESS IN THE SPIRIT*', St. Ignatius of Loyola '*DISCERNING LIFE'S JOURNEY*', and St. Therese of Lisieux '*SIMPLICITY OF FAITH*'.

This should be a very enjoyable and helpful Course. It will take place on Tuesday evenings in the Narthex, beginning on Tuesday October 23rd. Please put these six Tuesdays in your diary, and in the spirit of sharing the Faith, think of someone you could invite to come with you.....
